We are taking our Brownies to Seahouses for a weekend on 31st May. This is an opportunity for our members to go away together, many for the first time without their parents We would use £250 to provide half the cost of a bus there and back (lowest quote is £490). [we have

applied elsewhere for the other £250, but haven't had a response yet] The remainder would allow us to take the Brownies on a boat trip to the Farne Islands whilst we are the

The remainder would allow us to take the Brownies on a boat trip to the Farne Islands whilst we are there (£15 per girl) and discover the beauty of their county and some of its wildlife.

The cost of this modest, self-catered weekend is approx £110 per head, and we are looking to bring it down to less than £70 paid by parents. Partly from our current funds and partly with grants. If we were to receive a grant it would benefit all our members equally. We have also applied for bursaries elsewhere for a couple of members who wouldn't otherwise be able to come, even at the lower cost.
