Balloon and Sky Lantern Releases

Motion to Finance & General Services Committee:

That:

(i) Ashington Town Council supports Northumberland County Council's stance on balloon and sky lantern releases and formally adopts a policy that opposes the release of balloons and sky lanterns in Ashington,

(ii) A statement to be released on the Town Council managed website and social media platforms that publicises the Council's adopted position and sets out the negative environmental consequences of balloon and sky lantern releases; and that

(iii) An alternative list of suitable, ethical and eco-friendly environmental alternatives be published alongside the statement.
