Since our first event in July 2023 we have hosted 70 events and seen 4500 finishers as well as affording 229 volunteer opportunities. We have very close links with the NHS. Lintonville Surgery is an official parkrun practice and the apis and practice staff can socially prescribe parkin to their patients to improve physical Fitness, mental health and socialisation Our goals/priorities for this year are to improve our equipment so that we can enhance our event delivery. We are also endeavoring to grow

our participation and expand awareness of our event throughout the local community and beyond.

Each parkrun is supplied with a basic kit in order to operate. This includes high viz volunteer bibs, direction signs, defibrillatorsetc. The standard Finish funnel we were given is not suitable for our finish. We have stakes and our finish is on concrete on the stone circle. We are currently using old traffic cones acquired from the tip. Vandads have attempted to burn them and they look really shabby. We would really appreciate some funds to obtain more professional posts and chains. It would showcase our lovely event and indeed Ashington in a much better light, especially when we get visitors. The Friends of the woods are now letting us use their storeage facilities so any new kit can now be stored safely.

We would also benefit from some walkie talkies to improve communications between marshals during the event. This will enhance our response time and improve safety should we have a medical emergency or need to deploy the defibrillator

Finally our volunteers turn out in all kinds of adverse weather and we'd welcome some large golf style umbrellas to keep folks dry.
