SENRUG – The South East Northumberland Rail User Group – is a voluntary organisation that promotes rail travel and campaigns for better rail services (and bus – rail integration) in, within, to, from and through South East and East Northumberland, representing the interests of both existing and potential rail travellers in the area. By 'potential', SENRUG means those who would use rail services if only the trains went where they want to go, at the time they want to go, at a price they can afford, and in a clean, safe, secure, accessible and easy to understand manner.

SENRUG has led the campaign for the re-opening of the Ashington Blyth & Tyne railway line (now known as the Northumberland Line) which will provide a passenger rail link between Ashington and Newcastle for the first time in 60 years. Once opened, SENRUG will continue to campaign for further improvements and extensions to the line, to better improve rail connectivity in Ashington. We are requesting a donation to contribute towards our project costs for the 5 year period October 2024 to September 2029 for hosting, updating and maintaining our website, printing at least 12 copies of our award winning Newsletter, and producing a new full colour double sided DL sized leaflet highlighting our campaigns.

The breakdown of these costs are as follows:

Website hosting, maintenance and update support based on a fixed cost for 5 years of £295 + VAT per year **£1,771**

Printing 12 x 8-page A4 Newsletters over the five year period based on the average cost of £98 for our last 3 8-page Newsletters = £1,180

Design & Print 2,500 copies of a DL sized leaflet, full colour both sides, based on a cost of £510, which was the current price at March 2024, when our last leaflet was printed. (This price includes VAT on the design but VAT not applicable to the printing element).

Total project cost = £3,461 (All figures rounded to the nearest £)

Of the total £3,461, we are suggesting Ashington Town Council might like to contribute £500.
